

**College of Business Administration**  
**Faculty Meeting**  
**February 22, 2006**

The College of Business Administration Faculty met in Admin 2-48 at 2:00 p.m. with 37 faculty present. Dr. Ronald L. Berry, Dean, presided.

Aviation entered in the accreditation process which, to meet board requirements, must be completed by March, 2007. Computer Science accreditation will occur during 2007. The School of Construction report will be turned in May 2006. The CBA will begin to select an AACSB team. The review will be between September and November 15, 2007.

The CBA has approval to fill two of six open positions. The greatest need is in Accounting and the second greatest need is in Marketing.

**Undergraduate Curriculum Proposals:**

A motion was made to allow business majors “programs” to specify up to 30 hours in their discipline as part of their major. A secret ballot was taken and the motion passed.

CSCI 170 has been approved as a new course. Course title, description and syllabus was provided by Dr. Cordova via e-mail.

CSCI 170 will replace CINS 205 as part of the Business Requirements for business majors.

A motion was made to change the course title for CSCI 298

Old title: Current Topics

New title: Ethical and Professional Issues in Computing

The motion passed.

A motion was made to change the course description for CSCI 226. Introduction to Discrete Structures.

Current description: 3 cr. Set algebra, Boolean algebra, mappings, directed and undirected graphs. Prerequisites: Grade of “C” or better in CSCI 200 and MATH 113.

New description: 3 cr. An introduction to discrete mathematical structures with applications to Computer Science. Topics include: logic, proof techniques, set theory, combinatorics, and functions. Prerequisites: Grade of “C” or better in CSCI 200 and MATH 113.

The motion passed.

The safety issues for this quarter are “Back Safety” and “Risks and Symptoms of Ergonomic Injuries”. The information was provided by Miguel Perez via e-mail.

The CBA Faculty proposed to send a resolution to President Cofer expressing concern about the parking fees.
