Changes in the Aviation Curriculum: Approved.

For the Major in Aviation

Delete PSCI 103, 104 (2 hours) replace with applied elective hours
Delete MATH 112 as a core math option (Revised requirement: MATH 110 or
111 and 114)

Delete AVIA 301 - Aerodynamics
Require AVIA 415 – Aircraft Engines and Systems
Delete AVIA 330 – Aviation Professionalism
Require AVIA 230 – Aviation Professionalism
Identify BUSN 305 as the University Capstone requirement
Delete ENGL 220 – Technical Writing
Require ENGL 322 – Technical Writing
Require AVIA 402 – Air Traffic Administration
Require AVIA 470 – Airport Administration
Delete 6 hours of electives

For the Minor in Aviation

Delete AVIA 301, 402
Require AVIA 101, 230

Changes in CIS curriculum: Approved.

Require CINS 344 – Information Security Management
Require CINS 435 – Information Systems Design
Delete 6 hours of Business Electives
