Motion to allow traditional CBA majors to specify up to 30 hours changing the previous model of up to 24 hours in area and 6 outside of the area. Miller/Hayes, Approved.

Motion to approve new course: CSCI 170; Cordova/Clinton, Approved.

A discussion followed on whether to have traditional business students take or get credit for CSCI 167 (1 hour) and have 2 hours of electives or require CSCI 170.

Motion to remove CINS 205 and replace with CSCI 170 for traditional majors in the CBA. Clinton/Hayes. Approved.

Course title change for CSCI 298; Old title: Current Topics, New Title: Ethical and Professional Issues in Computing. Cordova/Smith. Approved.

Course description change for CSCI 226;

Current description: 3cr. Set algebra, Boolean algebra, mappings, directed and undirected graphs. Prerequisites: Grade of "C" or better in CSCI 200 and MATH 113.

New description: 3cr. An introduction to discrete mathematical structures with applications to Computer Science. Topics include; logic, proof techniques, set theory, combinatorics, and functions. Prerequisites: Grade of "C" or better in CSCI 200 and MATH 113.
